



NRCS purpose is:

identification of road network categories so an RCA can make them fit for purpose, to improve resilience, productivity and safety

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### NRCS outcome for RCA:

Road systems operate most reliably, efficiently and safely as each *category of road* is designed to serve its intended purpose taking into account function, context and value for money.





### NRCS outcome for users:

Building and maintaining road link according to their category will better match road user expectations - *self explaining roads*

### Timeframe:

Undertake consultation with RCAs and other user groups on a draft functional classification of roads

July 2011

Identify desired level of service and design parameters associated with each element of the system

October 2011

Undertake consultation with RCAs and other user groups on the proposed classification system

November 2011

Incorporate and update the system document based on feedback from the industry
