

## **SIG-LVR Work streams**

Objective: To review and progress the development of guidelines in accordance with the group's terms of reference in manageable sections.

### **Workstreams**

#### **1. Engagement**

Objective: To facilitate industry contributions and review of guidelines.  
Scope: Identify and engage with appropriate industry stakeholder groups with a focus on finding common ground.  
Deliver: All interested parties are involved in the development of the guidelines that reflect a best practice response to the issues.

#### **2. Pavement consumption**

Objective: To develop pavement consumption section of guidelines.  
Scope: Review processes used currently to identify the impact of heavy commercial vehicles on pavements and develop an agreed, robust and transparent measure of this impact.  
Deliver: A process able to identify the impact of heavy vehicles.

#### **3. Land use**

Objective: To develop the land-use section of the guidelines.  
Scope: Analyse land use and HCV traffic generation, both in-district and outside district, to identify the relationship between HCV road impacts and land use.  
Deliver: A process able to identify the impact of differing land uses on low volume roads.

#### **4. Business case model**

Objective: To develop a business case section for the guidelines.  
Scope: Develop templates, case studies and references.  
Deliver: Templates, case studies, examples and references to allow users to develop a sound business case for local conditions.

#### **5. Funding**

Objective: To identify all available options for funding the impact of heavy commercial vehicles on low volume roads.  
Scope: Identify options within LGA, Rating Powers Act, FAR and elsewhere that have the potential to fund maintenance due to unplanned pavement consumption.  
Deliver: A full range of options able to be adopted to provide funding.

#### **6. Overview**

Objective: To collate, edit and prepare draft guidelines.  
Scope: Prepare guidelines structure, proof checking, editing, arrange legal and other expert input as needed.  
Deliver: Draft national guidelines are ready for consultation and ratification.
