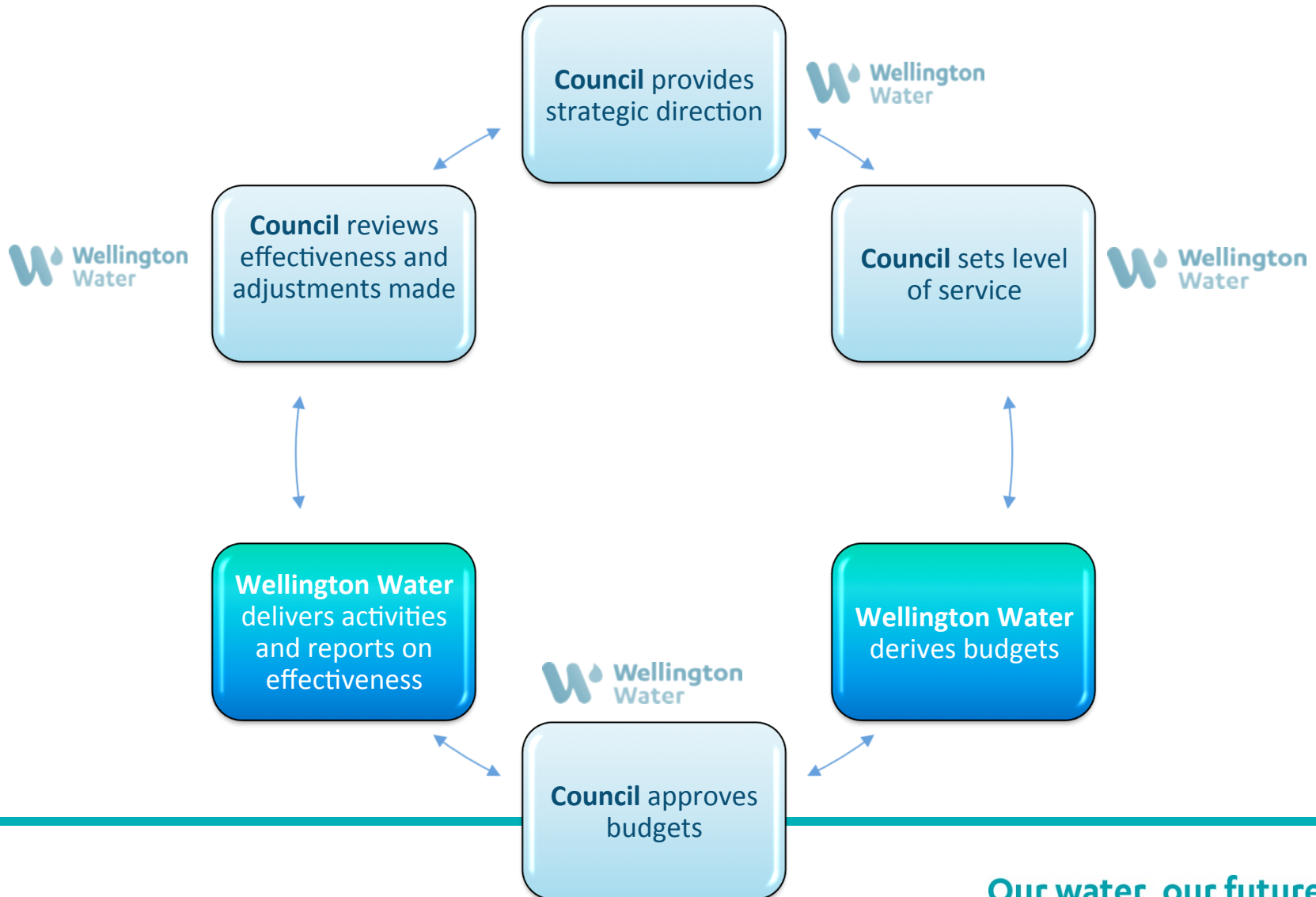

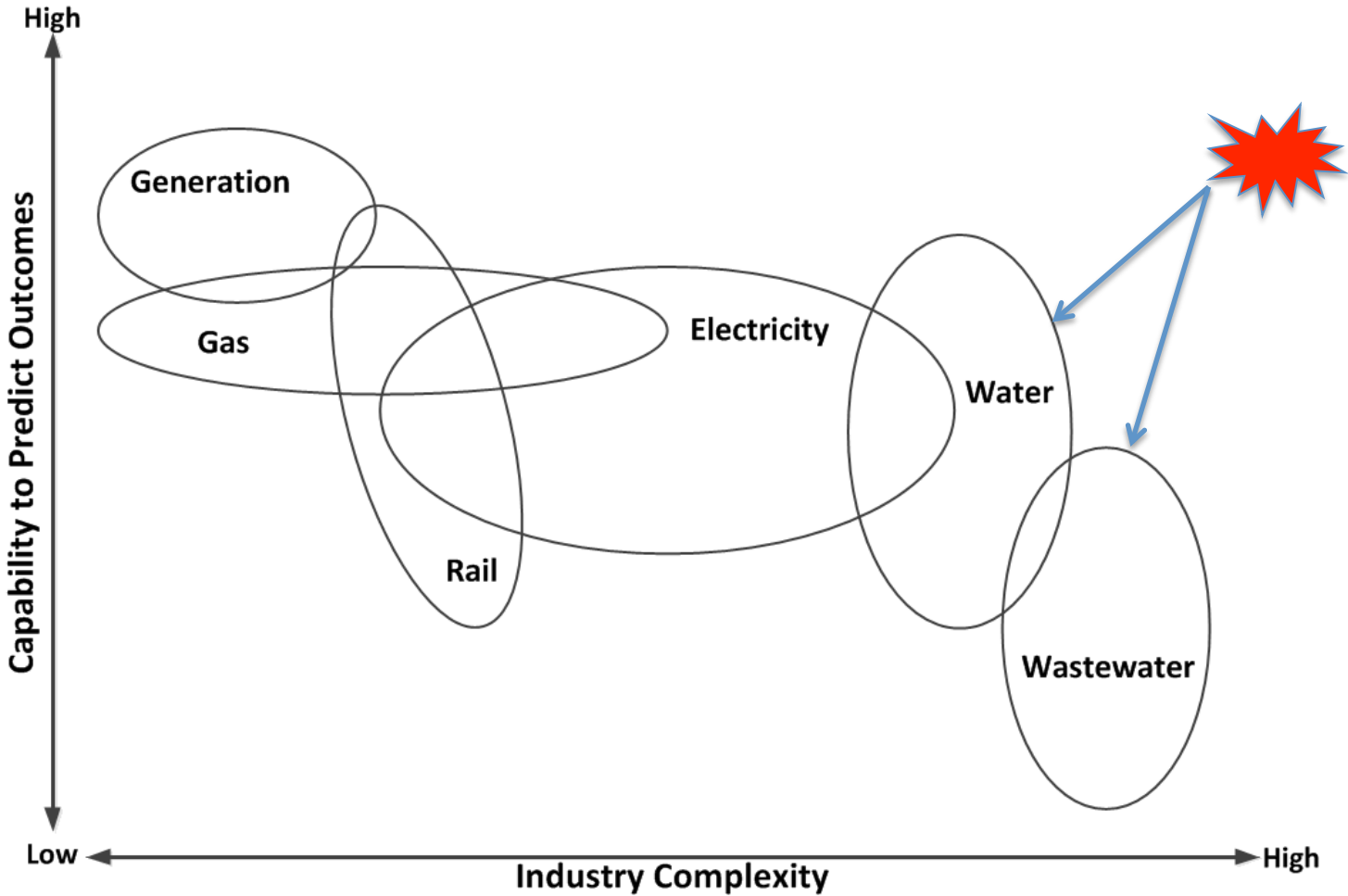

Complex Interdependencies:

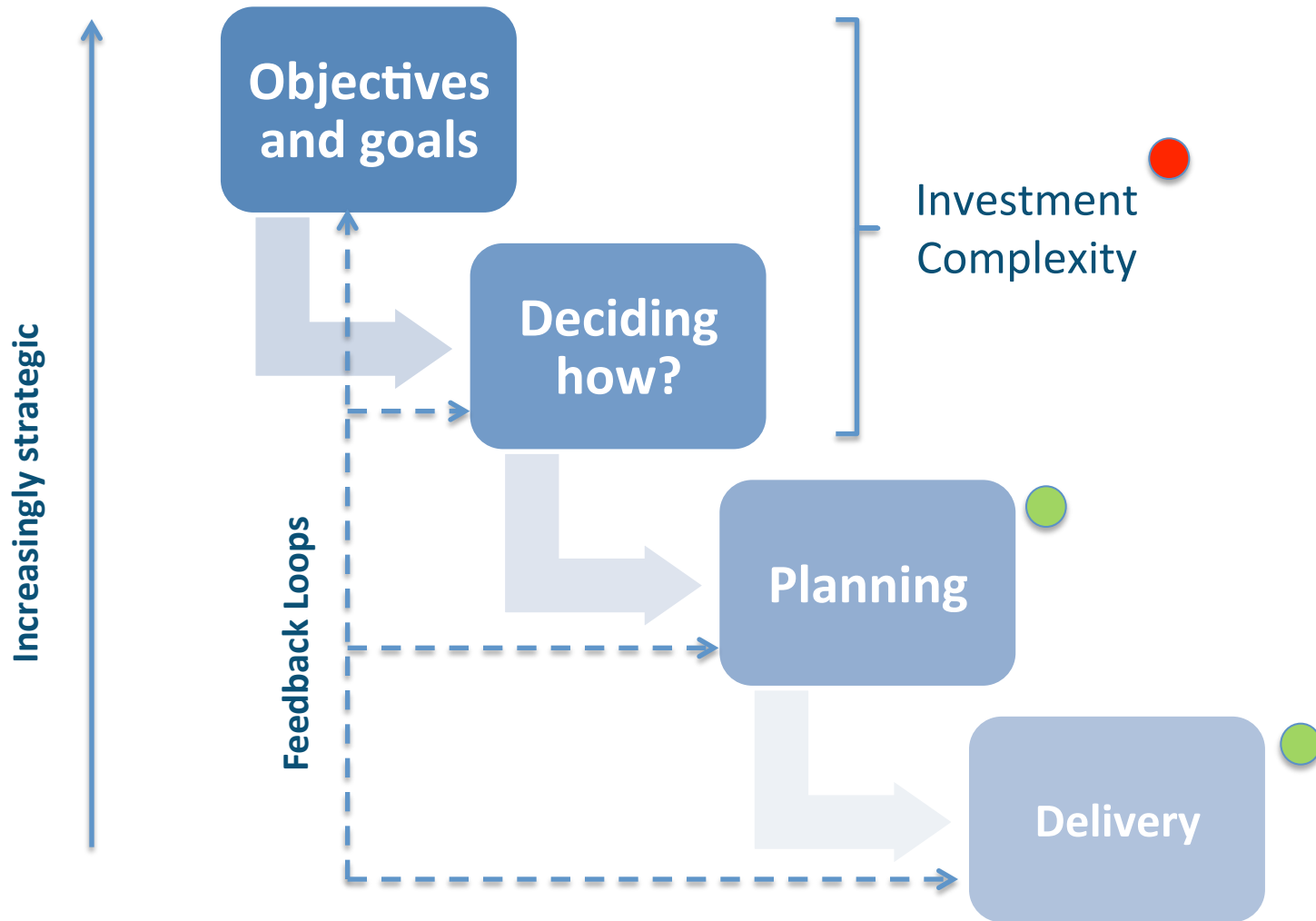
- One required to fix the other

Big Opportunities:

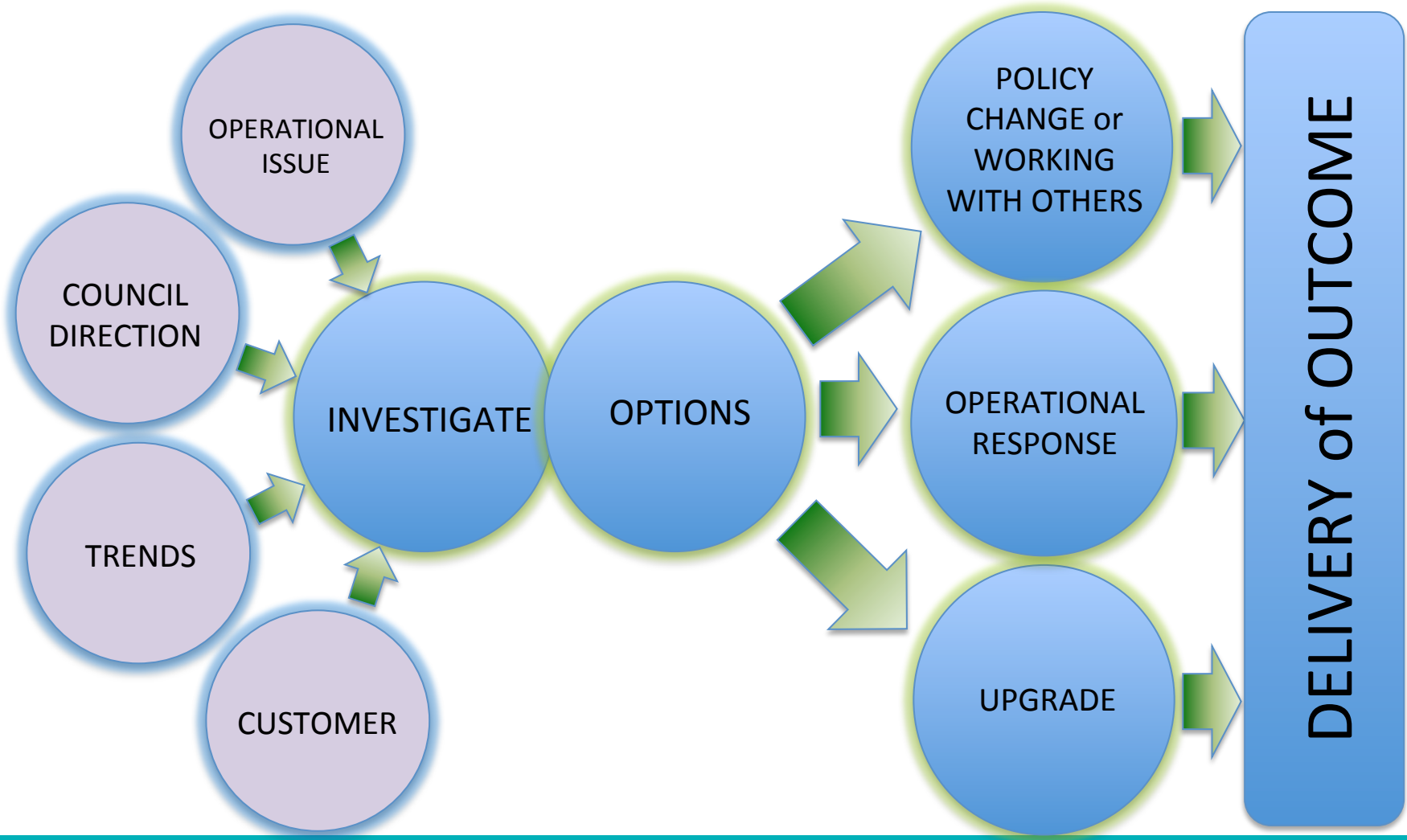

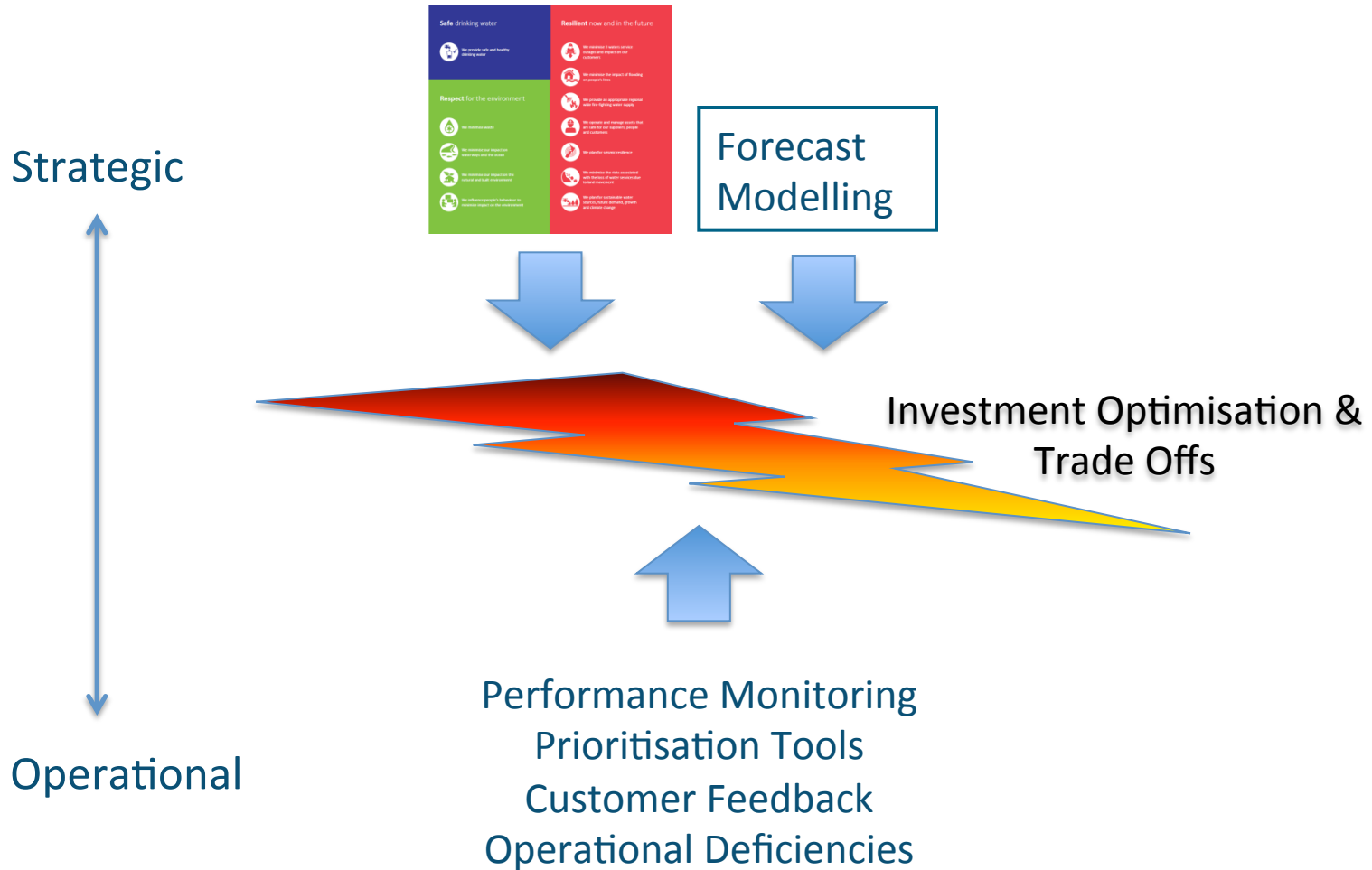

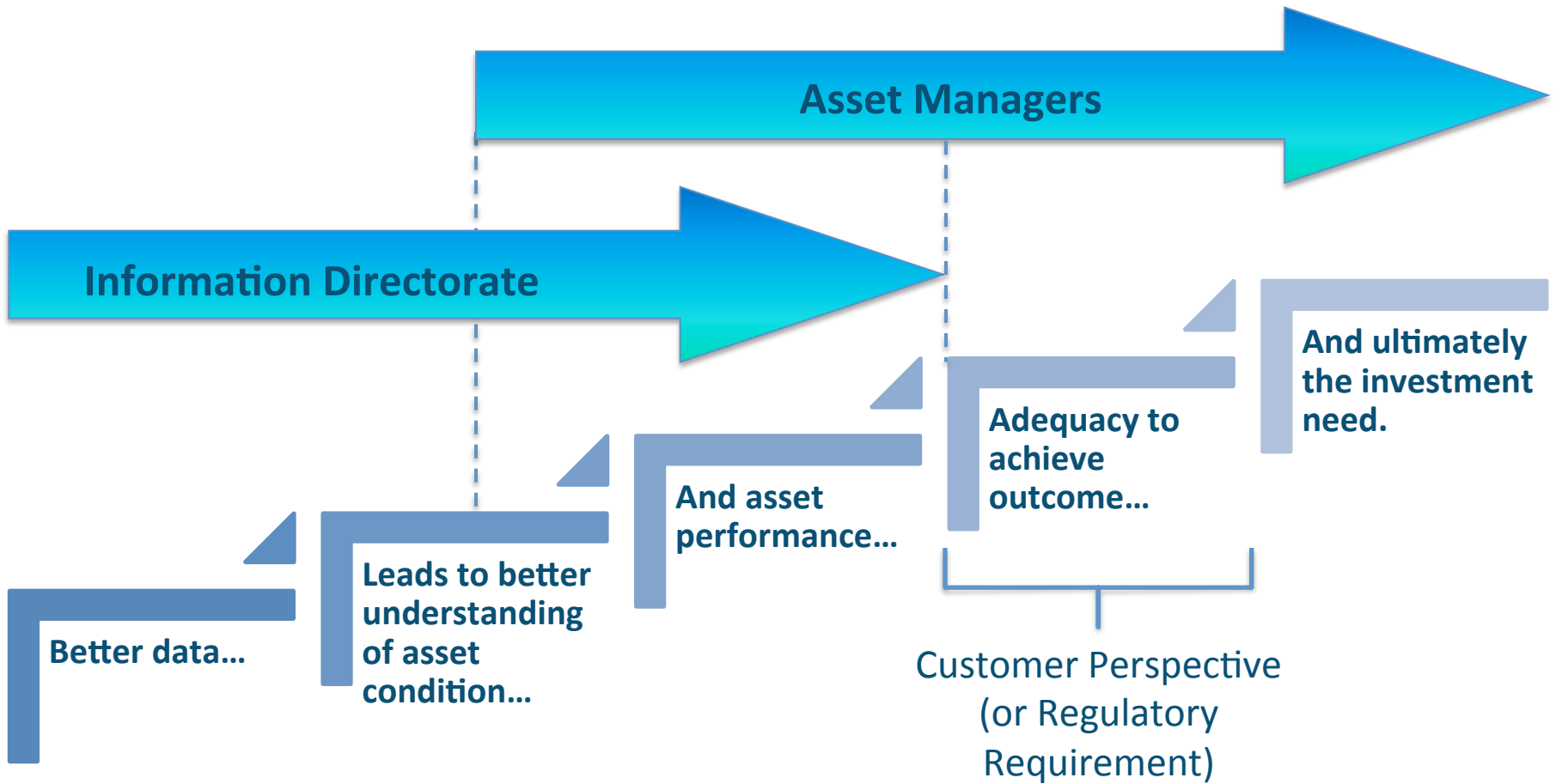
