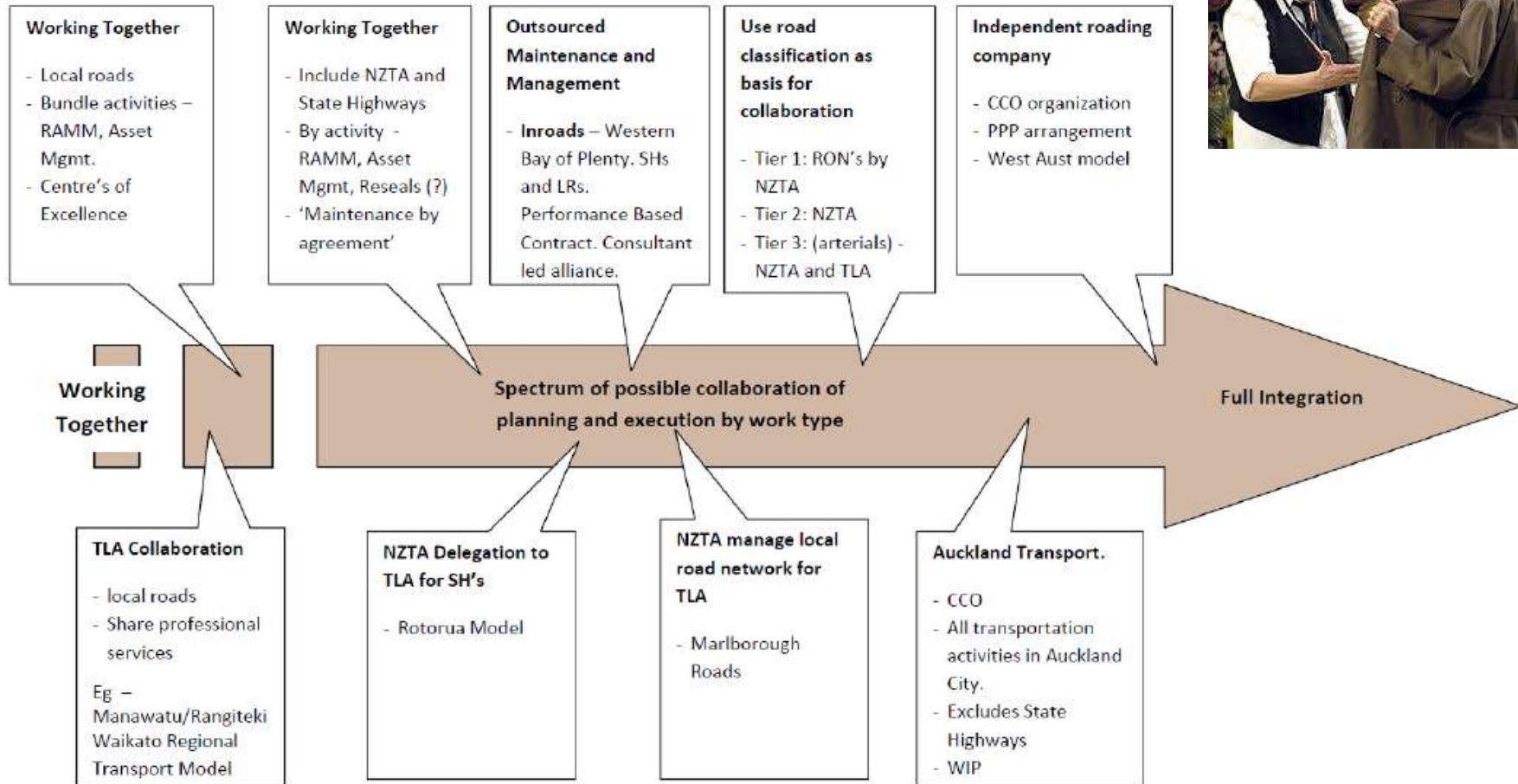
Benefits vs. Size
