The process so far

A working group comprising:

- Roading NZ / Contractors Federation
- Consultants
- NZTA Highways + Planning and investment
- A local government representative



Problems with the current mechanism

- Indexation method uses a fixed weight for bitumen
- Can over or under compensate
- Method is interpreted in a variety of ways
- Often it is perceived as unfairly allocating risk



The proposed solution

- Take bitumen out / treat it separately
- Pay monthly for bitumen cost fluctuation per litre
- Index all costs other than bitumen (new index)
- NZTA to provide a web based tool
- Test in 2011/12
- Go live in 2012/13



Studying the likely affects / seek feedback

- NZTA contracts being identified for testing
- Will test on historical data
- Need to test on local authority contracts
- New index being built (for non-bitumen costs)
- Web based tool to be built
- Go live once the methodology is proven
