 - Objective
 - To review and develop pavement consumption section of guidelines
 - Scope
 - Pavement analysis, evidence base
 - Progress
 - Beca studies in Northland
 - Next step- Southland analysis, Whanganui work



Land use

- Objective
 - To review and develop land use section of guidelines
- Scope
 - Land use analysis and relationship with HCV road impacts
- Progress
 - Tonnage per ha, rate share per ha, comparisons of land use
 - Next step discovery and consultation with industry










Business case model
