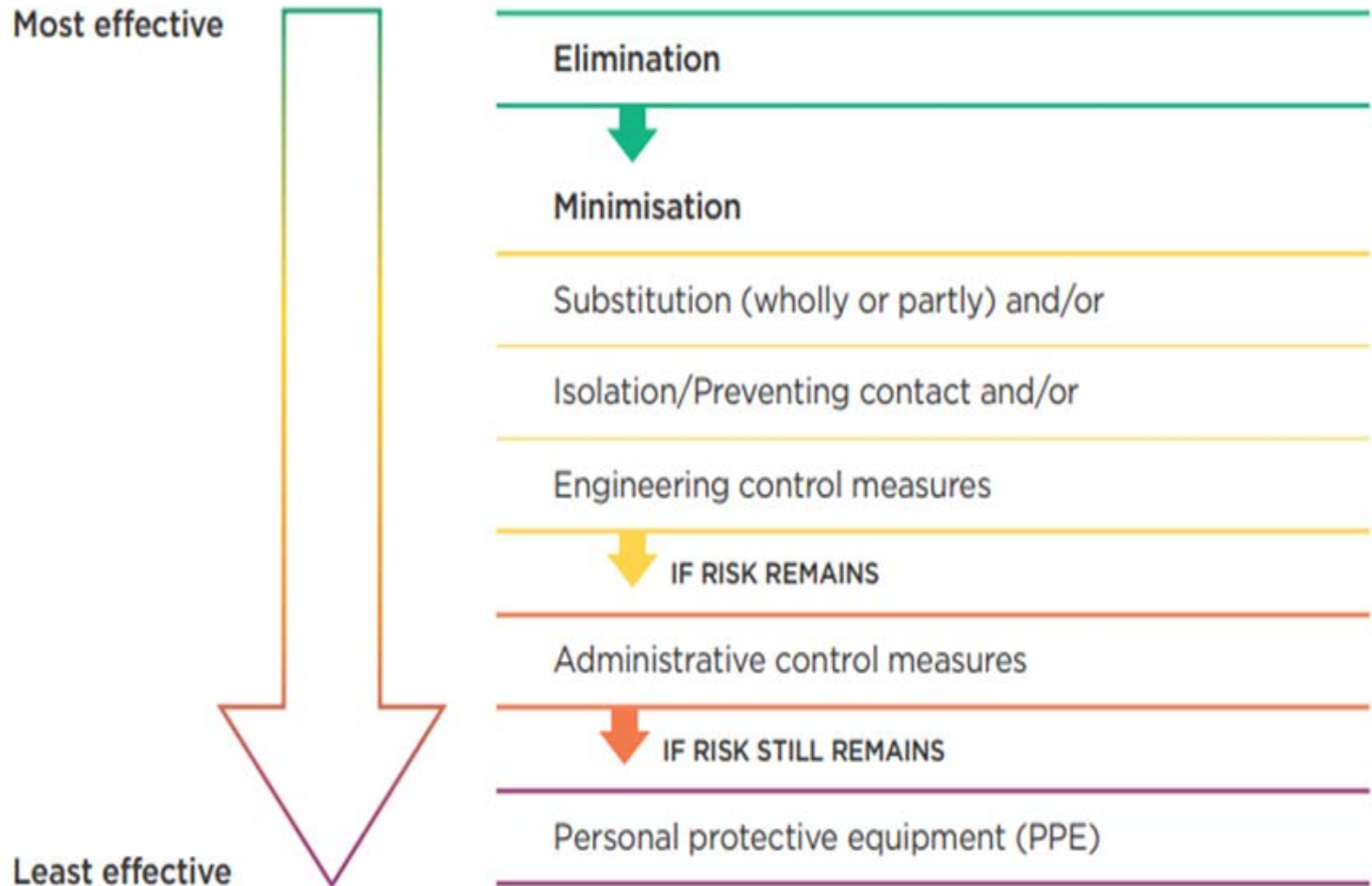
It's about caring about each other

TTM risk-based approach in practice

Eliminate

- FH - SH2 Remutaka Hill Road
- Higgins - SH2 Karangahake Gorge
- Downer - Boost 3 Line Marking

Substitute

- FH – Swapping Stop/Go for Traffic Lights
- Beca – Drone survey

Isolation

- Higgins - SH1 Dome Valley Barriers
- HEB - SH2 Waihi to Omokaroa Barriers

Engineering Controls

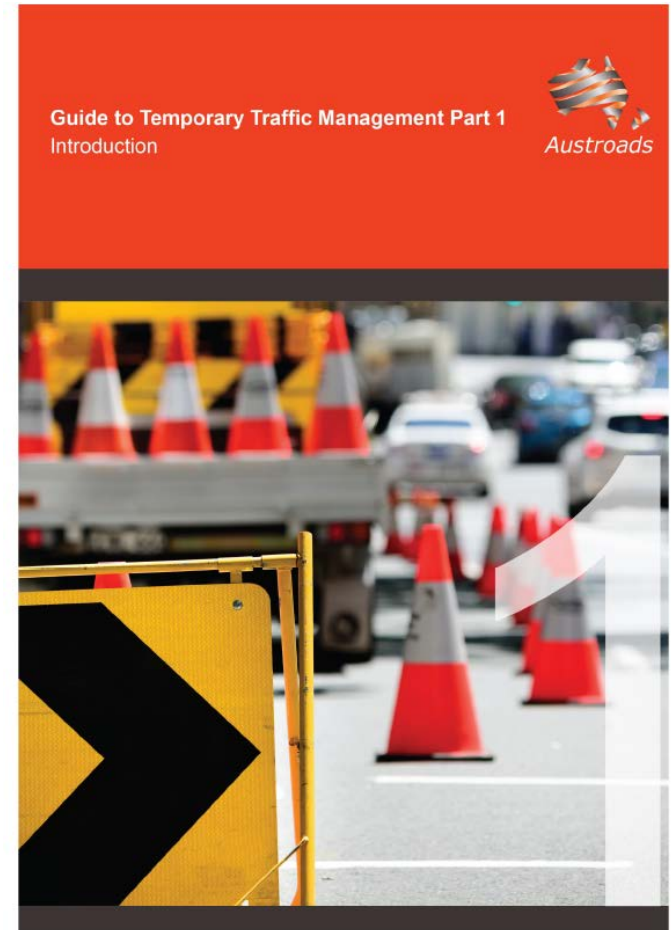
- Mash 3 TTM attenuators



COPTTM review (New Zealand Guide to Temporary Traffic Management – NZGTTM)

Looking to Austroads create the next generation of guidance

- AGTTM published in 2019
- Waka Kotahi will create the next generation of this document with New Zealand context
- Includes guidance on specific TTM risk management and “how to implement controls”
- NZGTTM “Risk” Part 10 – reviewed and available
- Industry workgroups completing their work and reporting to Waka Kotahi
- NZGTTM completed– Late 2021



Best Practice - Training and Competency

Desired Outcomes

- Improve practical competences of TTM workers
- Reduce HSW risk at TTM worksites
- Improve safe working practices across all TTM roles. Introduction of risk management.
- Introduce a career path for new and existing TTM workers
- TTM Planning completed at the earliest possible time



Best Practice – Innovation

Network mapping - understand what network risk look like:

- Critical risk criteria as well understood and are implemented as Business as usual.
- Separate work activity based risk vs road environment risk.
