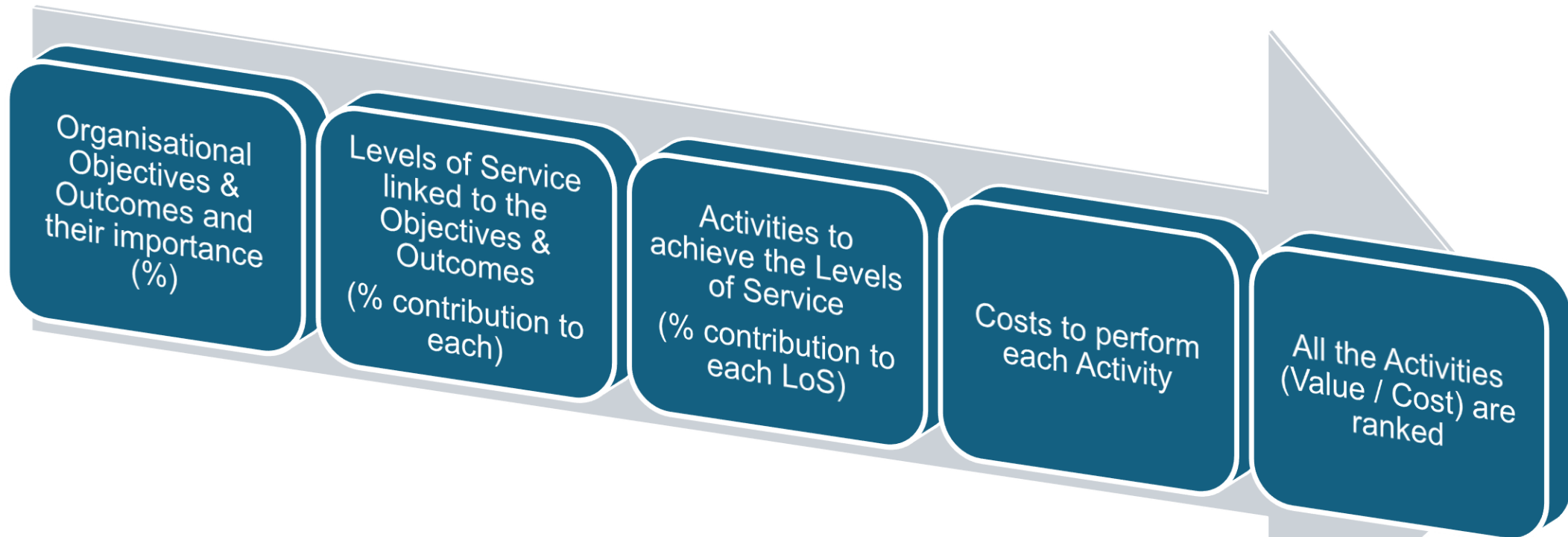

Challenge #1 - Value for Money (what our communities expect & deserve)

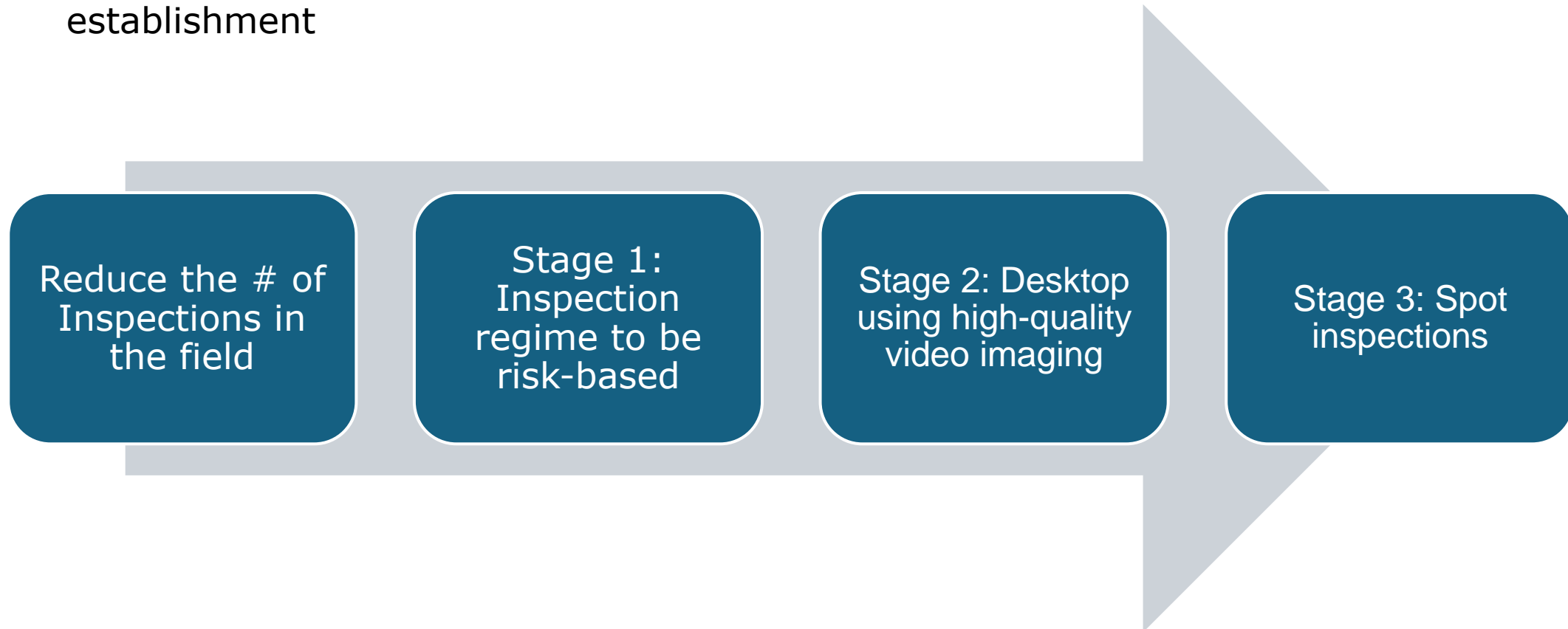


- If high Value and low Cost, consider refinements

 - if Yes, workshop a smarter way to undertake the task

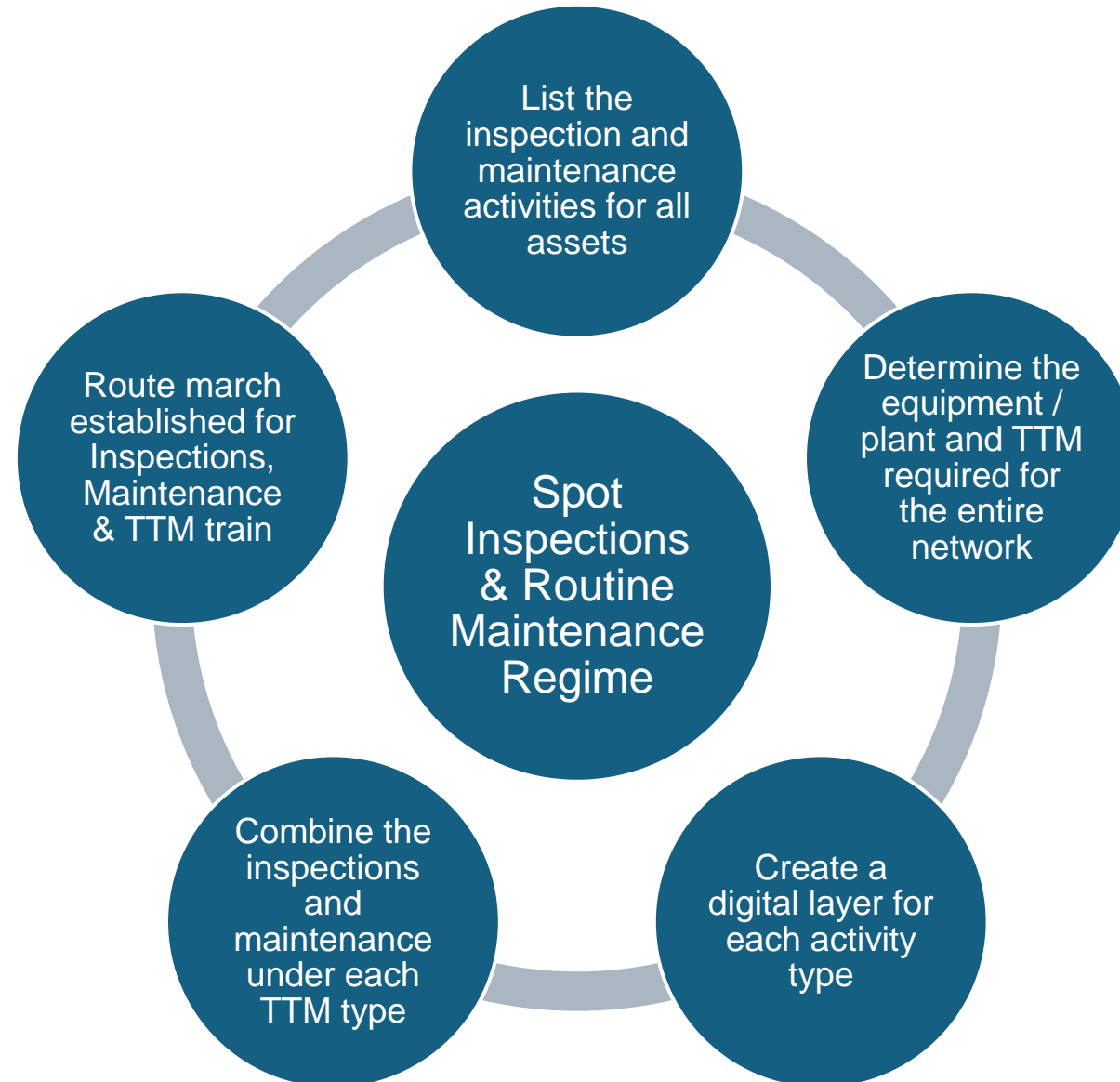
Challenge #2 - Inspections, Maintenance & TTM – The Step Change
