



The Planning Cycle

An LTPA amends the strategic direction or funding envelope of 1 or some parts of the LTP.

Sets the strategic and financial direction for the period of the LTP.

This is continued forward through Years 2 and 3 in Annual Plans

Annual Plans follow the same strategic direction and funding policies of the LTP, implementing the actions and funding as decided in the LTP. APs check the current financials and wider environment/economy, updating the forecast plan to ensure it is planning for the current situation.



Takeaways

- RLTP (and mid-term review) is be completed prior to GPS and NLTP being finalised, creating risk of
 misalignment and a 'lag' in catch up this is important, as alignment between the layers is
 important for Councils receiving government funding.
- LTPs are prepared and consulted on in advance of GPS and NLTP and alongside RLTP.
- There are lots of 'layers' to transport funding and decision making and long time periods in between reviews (which happen on different timescales), making funding of major projects that are needed in response to real world changes challenging
